Friends were people who hit you when you were hurting, they were undependable. I had that one so called friend that kept hitting me during gym class then would run away, until he got a little to brave and I caught him. I then grabbed his arm and twisted it until I heard something snap. For the most part of my life, I was a loner.

I turned to sports to help, but they were just games, not life or death, as most coaches and people thought they were. So, playing sport was not fun for me. I got to the point where I was angry. I couldn't see anyone in the busy high school hallways, but I saw the person who had made me angry. Luckily, I damaged objects instead of hurting people.

This was me. the point when I started dating Regina. The first thing my sister told her was that at the first sign of tears that she needed to walk away. Not to run because that would draw his attention because he was about to hurt or break something. The military drove this anger even more inward and made my hatred even uglier. Then my second son was born, and he had a seizure disorder and fragile x syndrome. Shortly thereafter I would be out of the military.

Once out, my wife started attending church. This left me home alone for a while with the boys. After a few months, I started to join her out of curiosity and a bit of selfishness, I suppose. The church had these two older ladies who would hug when you came in and would not take no for an answer. It was hard to handle at first, but then the church felt peaceful, as did the church. But things got worse with my youngest. The seizures got worse, and I found myself mad at God. It didn't make any since. I was the guilty one. I was the sinner. I was the hater. And here was this innocent, young child going through all of this. It really hurt and fueled my anger.

However, I kept going to church. The messages became more clear. Though it was in a song that my mean, hateful, heart broke. The message in the song showed me God cared. He cared about me, He cared about all of His children. Within the year I would be helping set up and tear down after services. After some time, I gave my heart to the Lord and was baptized. Like many, I was still trying to set the terms. I told God that I would never work with kids or make speeches in front of people.

This is where I found that God must have a sense of humor. The church we were attending would soon close down, but it led us to a new church. I would find myself involved in a puppet ministry working around children. Later, I was asked and became involved in a Prison ministry. During my time with the Prison ministry, I had to give talks in public in front of the inmates as well as the C.O.'s. the encouragement I find from my *crazy* wife and from the church has been life changing. By the way, never tell God what you are NOT willing to do. Those things that you tell Him you *won't* do...may be the very thing He calls you to do.


The character trait for April is Security. There are many in our world today who have problems with anxiety. With the Word of God, Worshiping with other believers and being on our knees in prayer.
